Given the importance of space technologies for numerous economic sectors as well as for society at large, it is necessary to strengthen our own capabilities in building, operation and usage of small satellites. Specifically, we aim to focus on developing the ability to build small satellites of size 6U CubeSats and higher, operate Earth-observation and spectrum monitoring payloads, followed by the practical use of satellite imagery and signal data. The subject of the donation may therefore consist of the following: 6U platform capable of carrying a payload for Earth observation or/and radio spectrum usage monitoring which will be delivered to Ukrainian side and at least components for such a platform to be integrated in Ukraine (in accordance with technical requirements).

Data protection information

The following information is provided on the basis of Article 13 of the GDPR¹:
